Name of Medication	Indications	Yes	No
Ibuprofen (Brufen Tablet / Syrup)	For headache, Toothache, Backache, abdominal pain etc,		
Paracetamol (Panadol Tablet / Syrup)	For mild to moderate pain and fever.		
Hyoscine Butylbromide (Buscopan Tablet)	For spasmodic abdominal pain.		
Loratadine (Claritin Syrup / Tablet)	For allergic symptoms such as sneezing, runny, / itchy nose / burning or itchy eyes, itchy and non-itchy skin rashes.		
Cetirizine (Zyrtec Syrup / Tablet)	For allergic symptoms such as sneezing, runny, / itchy nose / burning or itchy eyes, itchy and non-itchy skin rashes.		
Domperidone (Dompy Syrup / Motilium Tablet)	For upper abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting and heartburn.		
Light kaolin + Pectin (Kaptin Syrup)	For symptomatic treatment of diarrhea and dysentery.		
Aluminum Hydroxide + Magnesium Hydroxide + Simethicone (Moxal Plus Tablet)	For acidity, heartburn and nausea.		
Ivy Leaves Dry Extract (Prospan Syrup)	A herbal medicine for cough with / without sputum.		
Bromhexine HCl (Mucolyte)	Syrup mainly for cough with sputum.		
Butamirate Citrate (Sinecod)	Syrup mainly for cough with sputum.		
Oral Rehydration Salt (Prolyte)	For dehydration caused by diarrhea, excessive sweating, or due to heat or exercise.		
Salbutamol (Ventolin Nebule)	Improves breathing in Asthma, chronic bronchitis. Relieves chest tightness, cough, and wheezing.		
Diclofenac (Voltaren Gel)	Pain relieving Gel.		
Aescin + Diethylamine (Reparil Gel)	For contusions, sprains, bruises, and hematoma.		
Arnica Montana Mother Tincture (Arnica Gel)	Homeopathic medicine for minor injuries like: Bruises, pain, tenderness and muscle fatigue.		
Dimethindene Maleate (Fenistil Gel)	For itchy irritable skin problems.		
Sodium Fusidate (Fucidin Ointment)	For minor wounds and cuts.		
Silver Sulfadiazine (Silvadiazin Cream)	For burn wounds.		
Optrex Eyewash / Eye drops	For dry, or sore eyes.		
Lidocaine Hydrochloride (Medijel)	For mouth ulcers, sore gums, and denture rubbing.		
Betadine Oral Antiseptic Solution	For sore throat, throat inflammation and infection.
